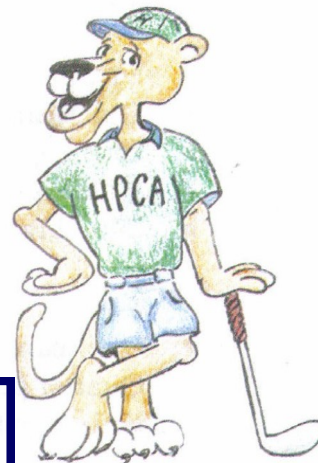

- [Harris Teeter](#) *Together in Schools* - relink your VIC card to HPCA each fall and the school receives a percentage of your sales each time you shop
- [Food Lion](#) - similar to Harris Teeter program, you just need to relink your MVP card each fall
- [Target](#) - obtain a Red Card and link it to the school, or link an existing Red Card
- [BoxTops for Education](#) - Collect BoxTops symbols off of participating products and then turn them in to either lobby
- [Campbell's Soup Labels](#) - Collect the labels off of participating products and turn them in to either lobby
- [Ink Cartridges](#) - send in any empty ink cartridges to either lobby
- [Cell Phones](#) - send in any cell phones that you are no longer using to either lobby
- [GoodSearch](#) - use goodsearch.com for your internet searches instead of Google and indicate HPCA as the charity that you would like to have the contributions go to
- [GoodShop](#) - use goodshop.com to purchase items through National companies such as Target, Amazon etc. and they make a donation to HPCA
