Opportunity Scholarship Program Information

High Point Christian Academy welcomes students who are recipients of the North Carolina Opportunity Scholarship Program. The Opportunity Scholarship Act was passed by the General Assembly in July 2013 and will assist students in attending the school of their choice by awarding families a certain amount toward tuition, per student each year.

OSP Applications for the new school year open on February 1st. To receive priority consideration, the priority deadline is March 1st. Families are still able to apply after the priority deadline of March 1st.

Parents must apply for tuition assistance each year through an online application process that requires tax returns and additional financial documents.
