PRESCHOOL

HPCA Preschool is a half-day preschool child enrichment program, supplemented with a full day of care. Our preschool fosters the physical, spiritual, intellectual, social, emotional, and spiritual development of our students. We provide sound educational practices consistent with Biblical principles. We serve children ages 18 months - 4 year olds.

ELEMENTARY SCHOOL

HPCA Elementary division offers a rigorous curriculum in a nurturing environment where every child is challenged to reach his or her full potential. Teachers utilize a variety of teaching methods and technology resources to reach all types of learning styles. Every class is taught from a biblical perspective. Students are trained to see the world through the eyes of Christ.

MIDDLE SCHOOL

Middle School includes grades 6, 7, and 8. Sixth grade has a seven period academic day, while the 7th and 8th grade classes operate on "A" and "B" Day block schedule, similar to high school. As part of the Academy's Life of Influence program, each middle school student completes a Servant's Heart project. Students focus on serving others in their own home, their extended family, and their community. Academically, Middle School students can participate in Student Council and Jr. Beta Club. Athletically, students can try out for a variety of sports. Beginning in the sixth grade, students participate in a Fine Arts wheel, where they get to find their talents in art, band, and choir.

HIGH SCHOOL

The High School academic program is excellent. All high school teachers are committed Christians with credentials to teach their subject areas. We offer three different levels of courses – College Prep, Honors, and Advanced Placement (AP). All three levels of courses are designed to prepare our students for the academic rigor of college. Not only do our teachers teach students their subjects effectively but more importantly they love their students and understand the importance of building lasting relationships! We also have an outstanding Fine Arts Department and a comprehensive athletic department.
