- Demonstrates experience in a school setting, teaching Bible to middle school students.
- Knowledgeable of the Bible (Genesis/Creation through Revelation/Eschatology) and can support the Southern Baptist doctrinal statement.
- Has the ability to orchestrate a highly organized, exciting, and dynamic learning environment.
- Has integrity, sound judgment, self-confidence, maturity, and a sense of perspective which means that he/she develops appropriate relationships with students and families.
- Has excellent interpersonal, presentation, writing, organizational, and communication skills.
- Is a self-starter and initiator, and is able to work independently and effectively on a team.
- Possesses a high level of energy and ability to work on many tasks and projects.
- Has a love for children and a willingness to go above and beyond on behalf of the students.
