

# Kindergarten Supply List



## Please label the following with your child's name:

- Bookbag
- 1 zipper pencil pouch
- 1 plastic pencil box
- Fiskar's Children's Scissors (Blunt Tip)
- 4 packs of 24 Crayola Crayons
- 2 packs of 10 Crayola Washable Markers
- 2 sets of double-row Crayola watercolors
- 2 sets of 12 colored pencils
- 1 set of Do-A-Dot Markers (6 in a pack)
- 1 pack of 2 yellow highlighters



## These items don't need to be labelled individually:

- 20 glue sticks
- Party Favors for Treasure Box
- Hand Sanitizer (just the boys)
- Baby Wipes (just the girls)
- 1 box of Kleenex
- 1 - 24 count pack of skinny, #2 Ticonderoga pencils
- 2 packs of dry erase markers
- Ziploc Easy Zipper bags - Quart (no stand and fill bottom) (just the boys)
- Ziploc Easy Zipper bags - Gallon (no stand and fill bottom) (just the girls)



## A few more notes for you:

- If your child is left-handed, consider buying them left-handed scissors.
- Please do not purchase skinny markers.
- Your child's book bag needs to be able to fit a 10 by 13 inch Manila Envelope (Friday Folder).



# Skills Needed for Kindergarten

Your kindergartener is expected to know the following skills on the first day of school:

## Behavior

- Follow directions the first time given
- Be able to complete one and two part directions
- Be able to complete a task within a given time frame
- Work on being patient - understanding that demands cannot be met immediately
- Work on impulsivity – blurting out, getting out of his/her seat
- Develop independence – putting own items away

## Motor Skills

- Tie shoes, button and zip clothing
- Cut simple shapes, lines
- Hold pencil or crayon correctly (dynamic tripod grasp)
- Use the restroom independently

## Academic

- Write first name legibly  
(Begin with a capital letter / all other letters lower case)
- Know phone number and birthday
- Write and recognize numerals 0-10
- Recite letters of the alphabet
- Recognize letters of the alphabet out of sequence
- Recognize the four basic shapes (circle, square, triangle, rectangle)
