Preschool Day Camp will begin at 18 months old. Elementary Day Camp will be offered for rising TK through rising 5th grade students.

Day Camp will provide a morning snack for all campers.

All students will be provided with a freshly-prepared lunch on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays each week.

If your child attends a Specialty Camp, you will receive a discount for our Summer Day Camp for that week. Registration and payment for Specialty Camps need to be done separately.

Online Registration form includes all billing information, registration fees (\$65.00 per student), and deadline for summer camp changes.

To register for the HPCA Summer Day Camp, go to the Registration link, and select "Summer Day Camp Registration Fee." You will need to pay a registration fee per child.
