Bible: Students will recognize that God is the Creator and that the Bible is absolute truth. They will be encouraged to accept Jesus Christ as their personal Savior and memorize Scripture verses.

Language: Students will identify and write upper and lower case letters of the alphabet. They will recognize and speak the sounds of letters and letter combinations in a phonics-rich environment. Students will build and write simple sentences.

Reading: Students will make predictions and recognize the general idea of a selection. They will read color, number, and high frequency words. Students will read beginning readers.

Math: Students will gain an understanding of number sense, recognize number order, and perform the operations of addition and subtraction. They will count, write, and sequence numbers to 100.



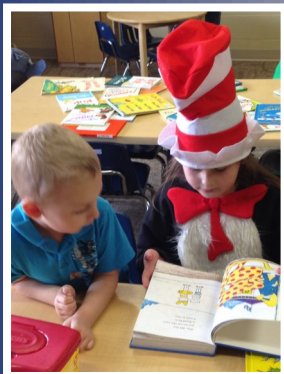
Social Studies: Students will recognize their role in a community and appreciate various community helpers. They will gain an understanding of people groups around the world and locate them on a map. Students will identify major US historical figures and holidays.

Science: Students will recognize that God's creation is designed with purpose and order as they study animal habitats, plants, seasons, and weather. They will explore their five senses to experience the world around them.

Social Skills: Students will learn to work and play cooperatively. They will follow multi-step directions.

Center Time: Students will reinforce the academic learning in small groups with crafts, free play, and collaborative work.

Specials: Students will attend one special class a day in art, music, media, physical education, or tech lab (K only). Students will participate in recess and rest time every day and Elementary Chapel twice a month.



TRANSITIONAL KINDERGARTEN has a greater focus on fine motor skills, social development, and imaginative play.
