Dear HPCA Families,

As we continue to monitor the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19), please be assured that we are keeping a close eye on the evolving situation and will keep you informed with the preparedness and prevention measures that HPCA is taking. The confirmed cases in North Carolina make it necessary for us to consider how HPCA can be best prepared.

The proactive measures HPCA is taking to ensure the health and safety of our students at the time are as follows:

- The HPCA Administration team continues to meet, review CDC materials, and discuss prevention measures.
- Hand sanitizer stations are being placed at all entrances of the buildings.
- The cleaning crew and staff are taking extra precautions by cleaning and wiping down all surfaces.
- If a student has a fever, students will be sent home per our sick policy. We encourage students, as well as adults, to visit the doctor if they have symptoms of fever, cough, and respiratory issues.

Currently, all upcoming HPCA field trips and sporting events are on as scheduled. However, we will continue to monitor and evaluate each trip in order to make the best determination of whether the trip would be wise or not. If you do not feel comfortable with your child attending off-campus events, please let us know and we will work on other accommodations for your child.
